Timara Easter was born and educated in St Albans. They have studied with Geoff Symon, Peter Dyke, Kevin Bowyer, Jeremiah Stephenson and Naji Hakim; the latter made possible thanks to generous support from the Savinka Foundation. Timara is a prolific transcriber of music for the organ; in particular the piano music of Erik Satie and Louis Vierne, most recently, Suite Bourguignonne, Op.17.

As a freelance recitalist, Timara has performed in many major churches and cathedrals across the UK, including Liverpool, Chester, St Edmundsbury, Blackburn, St Albans and Winchester Cathedrals, as well as several appearances at Kelvingrove Art Gallery in Glasgow.

Away from music, Timara has a keen interest in real ale and is an active member of CAMRA, as a regular volunteer at beer festivals.
